## Marriott Marquis - Chicago, IL

The Marriott Marquis Chicago, recently opened in 2017, soars 40 stories over the city's lakefront and South Loop, with 1205 guest rooms and over 90,000 square feet of meeting space. Spanning 350,000 square feet, the hotel has 299 luxurious guest rooms and suites on its 12 floors while offering 13 meeting rooms with over 20,000 square feet of space. The Westin's Harbour Island is located adjacent to the Tampa Convention Center and close to the Tampa Bay Times Forum, which hosted the 2012 Republic National Convention (RNC). Extenet deployed a multinode, multi-technology, multi-carrier network in a compressed 4-week time frame, to support the seamless connectivity and high-bandwidth needs for the over 35,000 attendees at the RNC.
